This specialized role focuses on providing holistic support to families experiencing perinatal and pediatric loss, guiding them through their grief journey with empathy, understanding, and actionable care.

Responsibilities:

- Offer one-on-one support to clients facing perinatal loss, including miscarriage, stillbirth, and neonatal death.
- Assist clients in navigating their grief and finding personalized paths to healing.
- Advocate for the needs of grieving families within the community and healthcare systems, ensuring they receive appropriate resources and support.
- Offer comprehensive support to families facing the loss of a child during the perinatal period or in pediatric stages, including miscarriage, stillbirth, neonatal death, and pediatric loss.
- Work closely with healthcare providers to ensure families receive compassionate and coordinated care, respecting their cultural, emotional, and spiritual needs.
- Facilitate healing spaces that allow families to grieve, share, and find support in a safe and nurturing environment.
